

2018 Summer School/ Credit Recovery



Burrell School District is pleased to offer courses through eAcademy to students who are in need of credit recovery or would like to maintain their skills over the summer break. All courses are offered online. Classes begin **June 14th, and end July 20th** and are for the purpose of credit-recovery, skill-maintenance, or both. Credit recovery courses are NOT an equal replacement for taking a course during the school year. This means that in order to be eligible for a credit recovery course, a student must have first taken the course and failed it during the regular school year. To confirm that a credit recovery course meets your district's requirement for credit, **confirm with your local guidance counselor. Please do not call the district that is offering the course to see if that course will be accepted for credit by your local district.** Only your local guidance counselor or principal can make that decision.

The [2018 Summer School Course Catalog](#) lists all the courses available for credit recovery. To register for a credit recovery course, please review the following steps:

1. Check with your guidance counselor to review eligibility for credit recovery
2. Complete the [Burrell School District registration form](#) (Must have valid email address, this is how we will communicate)
3. Each course costs \$155 for WIU7 consortium districts, and \$175 for outside consortium districts
4. Registration is NOT instant. If you have not heard from us in a week please feel free to call.
5. Burrell SD will not accept registrations after 3 pm on June 14th, 2018
6. Students not paid in full by the first day of school will be removed from the class.
