

Burrell School District
Modification of the Health and Safety Plan for School Activities

Athletic Director and Superintendent will continue to monitor state mandates, legislation and guidelines and modify the district's plan accordingly.

Based on the requirements, the following spectator procedures will be in place for each sport:

Requirements for Visiting School Spectators

- Spectators from the visiting team are not permitted to attend football and indoor events at Burrell School District due to the maximum restrictions.
- Spectators from visiting teams are permitted to attend soccer, cross country, tennis, and golf contests at Burrell School District.
- A face covering must be worn at all times and social distancing of at least 6' must occur.

Social Distancing and Face Coverings

- All spectators must wear a face-covering and maintain 6' of social distancing whether inside or outside.
- Spectators are expected to maintain at least 6' of social distance between each family. If spectators do not follow social distancing and facial covering guidelines, the school district may be forced to remove the spectator and/or eliminate spectators altogether from athletic events.

Football Events

- Band members and cheerleaders will be present along with spectators as identified below.
- Spectator Breakdown for Football Games:
 - 2 tickets per senior football player, band member and cheerleader.
 - 1 ticket per underclassmen football player, band member and cheerleader.

Soccer, Tennis, Cross Country, and Golf

The maximum number of attendees at any one event must not exceed 250 at any time.

Volleyball and other Indoor Sports

- Spectator Breakdown:
 - 2 tickets per senior.
 - 1 ticket per underclassmen.

Live Streaming

The school district will continue to stream varsity football, soccer and volleyball home events. Away events will be streamed when possible/feasible.

Concessions

No concessions for the fall season. If current mandates remain in place, concessions will not be permitted.
